AZA Ungulates - Application for TAG Endorsement

The AZA Ungulate Taxon Advisory Groups (TAGs) – overseeing Antelope and Giraffe; Caprinae; Deer; Equids; Rhinos; Tapirs; Wild Cattle and Camelids; and Wild Pigs, Peccaries, and Hippos – support and enhance the conservation of ungulates in the wild and in human care. Under the "AZA Ungulates" umbrella, we work together to promote programs that enhance the survival of ungulates.

- Drafted an evaluation process for projects to receive TAG approval
 - Currently 3 different formats
 - Additional projects needed for testing

Evaluation Tool Option #1- Capacity Assessment

Pros: Allows for weighting of categories, allows for justification of the score which could be us time to evaluate if a project has change;, allows for comparison across projects based on num outcome; should be quick to fill out if questions are written well.

Cons: Would need to establish what a 1 versus a 4 means for questions where answers would one of only two or three categories; categories like community involvement may be hard to co evaluate across projects with a 1-4 rating.


