Examples of detection effort in last four years

- 163,000 camera trap nights have been completed in five sites in Vietnam and Laos since 2017
- 98 individuals have been trained in saola dung collection across 17 sites and are actively sampling
- This effort is thanks to many AZA institutions support
- There is still hope for Saola. Even after intensive detection effort other rare species are still being found


So more, smarter effort in priority sites is needed!


