Premise:

- Historically it has been difficult to know who to ask when someone has an ungulate question
 - Much has been by word of mouth or calling your "favorite contact"
 - Multiple lists of advisors exist
 - Multiple levels of advisors exist
 - TAG level
 - SSP level
 - No structured format for where to list contacts
 - Many contacts weren't aware they were listed as advisors
 - Some were no longer willing but hadn't been removed
 - Some had changed institutions but contact info wasn't updated

GOAL:



Create a simple, centralized list of primary advisors, with a small number of co-advisors, who can field questions that arise regarding ungulate conservation and care AND ensure that answers are returned in an appropriate timeline.

Steps for creation:

- Determine all current advisors
- Contact current advisors to find out who is still active and interested
- Appoint Primary Advisors
- Primary Advisors appoint co-advisors
- Publish list in an easily accessible place
- Follow up to determine if requests are being answered and to make any changes needed to structure

- Yearly revisions:
 - Most likely at the TAG meetings
 - · Can discuss any improvements and / or changes as well as further uses
 - Will also confirm that advisors and co-advisors are able to respond to requests in a timely manner
