Condition


- Swelling of FL fetlock around (2019-2020)
 - Suspected trauma injury
 - Slight limp

Goals

- Decrease swelling
- Training on medical participation

- Oral medication
- Cold laser therapy







Swelling of FL fetlock around (2019-2020)

- Suspected trauma injury
- Slight limp
- Radiographs showing suspensory desmopathy and bone defect (2021)
 - Training hoof care and voluntary procedures
 - Off-and-on limp/lameness

Goals

- Trim hooves
- Promote comfort and stability
- Start welfare assessments

Condition



- Steroid injection, brace, ultrasound, aspiration, etc.
- Modified blocks

- Swelling of FL fetlock around (2019-2020)
 - Suspected trauma injury
 - Slight limp
- Radiographs showing suspensory desmopathy and bone defect (2021)
 - Training hoof care and voluntary procedures
 - Of- and-on limp/lameness
- Visible "clicking" when walking (2022)
 - Unstable on that FL leg
 - Drastic decline within 4-month period

Goals

- Increase rest
- Stabilize joint
- Start quality of life assessments

Condition



- Increase herd separation
- Surgery- full immobilization (Arthrodesis)
- Shoe placement (Sacramento)




Goals-Keeper Staff

- Communication
 - Record keeping
 - Group chats/zoom calls for decisions and updates
- Appreciation for all ideas
 - All on same level
 - Compromise
- Mental Check-ins
 - Decompress with snacks and second-breakfast
 - Appreciate time off
- Collective decision
 - Each step



Transparency

- Inside Zoo
 - No idea too small
 - All hands-on deck for training
- Public
 - Transparent and open as possible
 - Keeper chats, press releases, new signage
 - Public viewing for training







Decline

- March 2022 X-rays: show bones "disappearing"
- April 2022: Assumed self-mutilation
 - Biting on chest at open wound
 - •Possible side-effect of medication, self-induced, or habitat injury
- Drastic behavior change
 - Unwilling to participate in simple behaviors
 - Increased signs of frustration/aggression during training

Goals

 Create 2-week timeline for drastic change or euthanasia

- Surgery and biopsy
- Euthanasia

Wellbeing

- Consistent decline in assessments
- Unable to immobilize with given resources and time
 - Exhibit out of date
 - Scheduling outside timeframe
- Showing drastic decline in 2-week timeframe
 - Limp and lameness
 - Quality of life





- Humanely euthanized (May 29, 2022)
 - Trained for voluntary injection
 - Full staff participation
- Tissue from fetlock sent off for biopsy
 - Suspected cancer, no results yet
 - **Necropsy photo ahead**
















Conclusion

- Strong connections
 - Luxury of an extensive budget
- Open and honest communication
 - Not all on agreement 100% of the time
 - All ideas on same level
- Establish common Goal
 - · Get her stable within each timeframe
 - Move on to next idea
- Documenting consistent results
 - Each new effort came with little improvement
- Strict time frame
 - Choice made with Abi in mind
 - No pushing the limit- no matter the available options



Abi's Legacy

- New barn Oct. 2022
 - Made with full sedation in mind
 - Herd doing great
- Better trainers, better team
 - Hoof work and communication
- Made the right call, even when we haven't tried everything
